# FIRE RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

**EFFECTIVE SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2011**

The Smith Valley Fire District announces the **lifting of fire restrictions on Saturday, October 8, 2011**. The District is lifting the fire restrictions that have been in place since July 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Restrictions expire at 12:01 a.m., Saturday morning, October 8, 2011.**

The Smith Valley Fire District urges the public to be extremely careful with any fire. Wildfire danger remains because of warm daytime temperatures and continued dry vegetation.

**Open burning, including the use of burn barrels, must be conducted in accordance with the Smith Valley Fire Protection District Open Burning Regulations.**

Remember that any person conducting open burning may be held liable for response and suppression costs, property damage and injury resulting from open burning activities.
